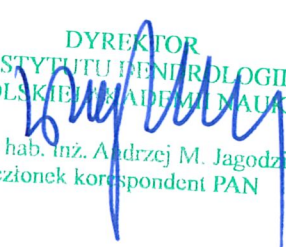

I. REQUIREMENTS FOR CANDIDATES

1. Doctoral degree in the field of biological sciences, forestry or related disciplines;
2. Knowledge and publications in the field of biology and ecology of woody plants and forest ecosystems, consistent with the research carried out at the Department of Ecology, with particular emphasis on physiology, molecular biology and ecology;
3. Broad experience in laboratory and field studies;
4. Scientific achievements including at least 10 publications published in journals indexed by Web of Science with a total IF_{2-year} at least 15, including at least three published papers as a leading author (first author);
5. Experience as a Principal Investigator in at least one scientific or research-development grants;
6. Proficiency in English (speaking and writing);
7. An additional advantage will be having an abroad internship or internship in a research institution in Poland;
8. Readiness to participate in scientific expeditions and training (in Poland and abroad);
9. Aptitude for scientific research and teaching as an assistant professor;
10. Submitting a declaration that after employment the employee agree to be included in the number of employees conducting scientific activity at the Institute of Dendrology PAS, in accordance with art. 265 paragraph 5 of the law on higher education and science;
11. Submitting a declaration that after employment, the Institute of Dendrology PAS will be the place of primary employment.

4. Self-report (autoreferat) presenting the candidate's scientific, teaching, and organizational activities, together with documentation confirming research achievements;
5. Professional development plan for the next five years;
6. Consent to the processing of personal data (Annex No. 2).

We ask foreign candidates and Polish citizens who have obtained a professional title or academic degree abroad to check whether the diploma they hold may be recognized as equivalent to Polish one.

Written information about the diploma obtained abroad, in particular about the level of education and the status of the university, is provided at the request of the person concerned by the Director of the National Agency for Academic Exchange. Information is provided on the basis of documents submitted by the applicant.

At the stage of the recruitment process, there is no requirement to present documents certified with the apostille clause, nor a requirement to nostrificate diplomas. These requirements must be met after the candidate is accepted.

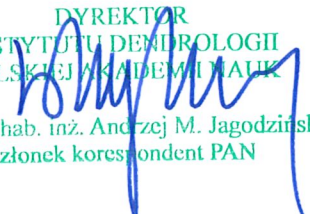

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Information Clause (GDPR)

Pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 (General Data Protection Regulation – GDPR) regarding the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, the Institute of Dendrology, Polish Academy of Sciences informs that:

1. The controller of your personal data included in the recruitment application and attached documents is the Institute of Dendrology, Polish Academy of Sciences, ul. Parkowa 5, 62-035 Kórnik, Poland.
2. The controller may be contacted by email at iod.idpan@man.poznan.pl or by post at the Institute's address with the note "Personal Data".
3. Personal data will be processed for the purpose of conducting the recruitment process for the position indicated in the announcement.
4. Personal data specified in Article 22¹ of the Polish Labour Code are required for recruitment and processed under Article 6(1)(c) GDPR (legal obligation). Other data exceeding this scope are processed based on consent (Article 6(1)(a) GDPR), which may be withdrawn at any time. If documents contain special categories of data referred to in Article 9(1) GDPR, consent for their processing will also be required (Article 9(2)(a) GDPR).
5. Consent may be withdrawn by sending an email to iod.idpan@man.poznan.pl or by post to the Institute's address with the note "Personal Data". In case of withdrawal, the data processed on the basis of that consent will be deleted immediately.
6. Personal data will be processed until the end of the recruitment process and deleted no later than 3 months after its completion, unless consent is given for future recruitment processes. In that case, data will be processed for a maximum period of 12 months from the date of collection.
7. Personal data may be: a) entrusted to technological partners providing services such as hosting, email delivery, statistical services, social media management, and software development and maintenance;
b) disclosed to law enforcement authorities and public administration bodies where legally justified.
8. You have the right to access your personal data, obtain a copy of it, request correction, deletion, restriction of processing, and the right to data portability (for data processed on the basis of consent).
